Communion Policy for Shepherd of the Ridge

In Holy Communion, the baptized Christian receives the true body and the true blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, in, with, and under the bread and wine of the Lord’s Supper for the forgiveness of their sins.

Our Lord invites to His table those who trust His words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us, that we may show forth His death until He comes again in glory.

As a congregation of the Lutheran Church--Missouri Synod, we at Shepherd of the Ridge practice what is known as “close communion.” We acknowledge that faithful Christians can be found in other Christian denominations. The Lord’s Supper is a confession of the unity of our faith. By partaking in the Lord’s Supper here, you are uniting yourself with the church’s teaching and confession.

Nicene Creed


